	Doormats (indoor and outdoor to trap dirt)
	Heavy-duty broom or push broom (for garage, basement, patio)
	Outdoor cleaner or hose attachment (for siding, walkways)

	Lockable cleaning caddy or cabinet (for homes with kids or pets)
	Labels or marker for spray bottles (for homemade solutions)

	Hand sanitizer (near entry points during move-in)

	All-natural pest spray or traps (as needed in your area)
